Eligibility for Australian Public Dental Services for Children Summary

Universal Eligibility Ages 5-16 = All Children in all States / Territories (except QLD from 4yrs & Vic where it only goes up to 12) - Free all States / Territories except ACT, SA, Tas & Vic

Universal Eligibility Ages 0-4 = All States / Territories except QLD, WA where it is concession holders only - Fees apply for ACT, Tas, Vic & WA

Universal Eligibility Ages 17- 18 = Universal for NSW, NT, SA & Tas; Concession holders only ACT, QLD, WA & Vic (13-18) Fees apply for ACT, SA, Tas, Vic & WA
